### **Hospital Systems**

Presbyterian-Construction of the sky bridge will need the hospital to close for approx. 6-9hrs. for completion on 10/6. Plan is for ED divert for that day for any agency. Scott Casper getting ahold of other agencies. Central will be blocked off for that day.

Dr. Pruett explains that diversions have not been allowed in the past. Stated, "since this is an exception to the rule I think we probably should vote on diverting traffic for that day from Presbyterian down town."
