Protocol Updates/Discussion-

- I.** Pediatric needle decompression needle size- standardize the cath used. Taking out the 18g cath for pt's under 8
 - a. Motion to accept taking away the 18g needle made by Dr. Medoro and seconded by Dr. Habrat
- II.** Pediatric joule settings on the Lifepak in AED mode-LP 15 when placed in AED mode there is no way to change the joules lower so it will deliver 360J no matter what. Language will be changed to not use in children under 8 by providers under the EMT-P level.
 - a. Motion to change the language to no defibrillate children under 8yo. For LP 15 only if AED available it is ok made by Dr. Medoro and seconded by Dr. Habrat
- III.** AFR COVID dispatch screening stopped 1 July-if volume does spike this board reserves the right to restart the screening. County still asking if anyone in the house has COVID or if the pt has been vaccinated.
- IV.** AFR Leave behind Narcan program- Found a Grant to obtain the Narcan he has available.
