- I. Call to Order**
  - a. The meeting was called to order at 5:33 pm with Chair Britton, Vice-Chair Baca and members Davis, and Robb.
- II. Introductions**
  - a. All who were present introduced themselves.

  - a. Council members discussed barriers they face in public spaces. They also discussed other areas there maybe barriers for others. Areas included private

businesses, sidewalks, and schools. Chair Britton talked about Disneyland having a map of the park and labeling accessible points and where you may find difficulty accessing areas and asked whether the City could do the same. Ms. Brunner stated this could be a recommendation from the Council to the City. A member of the public shared the importance of this Council knowing how much the City has allocated for sidewalk improvements. She also felt it was important to invite those departments to meetings to discuss their progress.
