UN <i>M Updates,</i> Rodney McNease	Rodney McNease said the group working on the respite project has done a site visit at Gibson Health Hub; planning meetings continue. By next meeting of this committee, should have a more updated plan around respite and what is being proposed.
Q&A and Wrap Up	There was one question from the public: there was a meeting with faith-based organizations recently – did anything relevant come out of this? Lisa Huval said that there was an event last week at the Gibson Health Hub, an update to the faith community and initial thinking on ways to partner with the faith community (for example, at similar Tucson project there were 'sponsor rooms' opportunities for organizations including the faith-based community).
