

COLD WEATHER SHELTERING PLAN 2024-2025



ACTIVATION OF EMERGENCY SHELTERING

- 1. Forecasted temperature below 15°F.
- 2. Wind Chill Advisory, Watch, or Warning issued by the National Weather Service resulting in "feels like: temperatures below 15°F
- 3. Two inches or more of snow forecasted, or existing snow accumulation prevents safe access to shelter.

STAFFING

Staffing will be determined on a case by case basis.

TRANSPORTATION:

First responders (ACS, AFR, APD and City Security) will provide 24/7 drop-off and support staffing for the overflow shelter, ensuring safe and secure operations for additional clients.

EMERGENCY SHELTERING ACTIVATION STEPS:



STEP 1 Expand capacity at Gateway West by 30 beds



STEP 2:

Overflow sheltering is activated at Gateway Center.

STEP 3



If demand continues to rise, we will expand the Gateway West contract to add 10 additional cots in each dorm, accommodating 100 additional clients.

STEP 4

If additional capacity is needed, Multigenerational Centers and Community Centers to be activated by OEM.
