FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)

NOTICE OF 5-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Notice is hereby given that the City of Albuquerque proposes to amend its 2020 Annual Action Plan, the third year of the 2018- 2022 Consolidated Plan. This Sixth Substantial Amendment proposes to allow the City of Albuquerque, Department of Family and Community Services (FCS), to utilize Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus funds (CDBG-CV). Funds will be provided to two agencies to provide emergency motel vouchers to homeless individuals and families, persons with medical and/or mental health conditions, women, and women with children. The following agencies will be receiving funding:

Barrett Foundation:	\$396,207.00
Albuquerque Healthcare for the Homeless:	\$218,364.00

A statutory, 5-day public comment period will begin January 7, 2022 and end on January 12, 2022 at 5:00 PM. All residents, property owners, persons with disabilities, immigrants, seniors, low-income, children and youth, homeless persons, and other stakeholders of the City of Albuquerque are encouraged to submit written comments or questions regarding the proposed Sixth Substantial Amendment to the 2020 Annual Action Plan to Monica Montoya, Department of Family and Community Services, located at Old City Hall, 400 Marquette NW, 5th Floor, Room 504, Albuquerque, NM 87102, or email at mtmontoya@cabq.gov.

Summary:

The City of Albuquerque's 2020 Annual Action Plan, the third year of the 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan, requires that this proposed change to the Plan undergo a substantial amendment process. The substantial amendment must include public participation and a comment period of 5 days.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact. The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development determines the amount of Entitlement funds that the City of Albuquerque receives each year. The proposed change to the Annual Action Plan through this amendment only involves a change in how the funds will be distributed.

Background:

The City of Albuquerque is a HUD "entitlement" community. The funds are allocated from HUD directly to the City of Albuquerque and do not pass through the state government.

Public Participation:

All Albuquerque residents, property owners, persons with disabilities, immigrants, seniors, low-income, children and youth, homeless persons, and other stakeholders in Albuquerque are invited to review this proposed Sixth Substantial Amendment to the 2020 Annual Action Plan and comment on it in writing, until 5:00 PM on January 12, 2022. After receipt of public comments from the 5-day public comment period, the City of Albuquerque will address each comment in writing and will submit all comments and responses in its formal Sixth Substantial Amendment to HUD.
