11 12 13 14	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Parties have entered into a Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") on behalf of all Albuquerque Police Department Sworn Officers through the rank of lieutenant effective July 15, 2023, and terminates on June 30, 2026.			
15 16 17	<b>WHEREAS</b> , Section 35.1 of the CBA allows the Parties to enter into written Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) during the term of the CBA, and			
18 19 20 21	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Parties recognize Department services on behalf of the City's domestic abuse victims continue to be a priority for the Department, and			
22 23 24	<b>WHEREAS,</b> the Parties further recognize and agree a new Domestic Abuse Response Team (DART) needs to be established, and			
25 26 27	<b>WHEREAS,</b> the Department has received grant funding to assist in the start-up of the DART program, and			
28 29 30 31	WHEREAS, Officers will be selected to participate in this program from the Field Services Bureau as a collateral duty, and the Officers shall be paid Specialty Pay for this collateral service,

35 36 37 38 39	I. Term of MOU. This MOU is effective the date the last party signs the agreement and shall remain in full force until the current CBA expires or until a successor Agreement is reached, whichever occurs last.

41 42 43 44 45 46 47	1. Selected Officers shall be paid \$50 per paycheck Specialty Pay for their participation in the DART program. Officers who qualify for this Specialty Pay shall be compensated retroactively to July 15, 2023.			

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3	III.	No Further Agreement. This MOU incorporates all the agreements, covenants,
4		and understanding between the parties hereto concerning the DART Specialty
5		Pay to be enacted hereunder, and all such agreements, covenants, and
6		understandings have been merged into this MOU. This MOU expresses the entire
7		MOU and understanding between the parties with respect to said services. No
8		prior agreement or understanding, verbal or otherwise, of the parties or their
9		agents shall be valid or enforceable unless embodied in this MOU.

11	I.	Severability. In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this MOU
12		or any application thereof shall be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect,
13		the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained
14		herein, and any other application thereof shall not in any way be affected or
