Professional Development

- Three (3) years discipline specific forensic experience + applicable advanced scientific degree or
- Four (4) years discipline specific forensic experience + discipline specific certification from the SED Director's Approved List or
- Five (5) years of discipline specific forensic experience

Laboratory Participation

- Documented participation in at least ten (10) public or professional presentations (i.e. FI schools, OMI schools, citizens police academy, school groups, philanthropic groups, etc.)

Forensic Participation

- Participation at a minimum of five (5) forensic related professional workshops or conferences totaling at least 100 hours of training approved by the technical leader and
- Membership in a discipline specific forensic organization from the SED Director's Approved List

Discipline Expertise

- Satisfactorily proficiency tested in the applicable forensic discipline, with no level I discrepancies within the last three (3) years (according to the APD Crime Laboratory Quality Manual) and
- Capable of performing completely independent casework in all respective areas of the applicable forensic discipline and
- Successfully testified in a court of law in the applicable forensic discipline
