## **Professional Development**

- •Three (3) years discipline specific forensic experience + applicable advanced scientific degree
- •Four (4) years discipline specific forensic experience + discipline specific certification from the SED Director's Approved List <u>or</u>
- Five (5) years of discipline specific forensic experience

### **Laboratory Participation**

•Documented participation in at least ten (10) public or professional presentations (i.e. FI schools, OMI schools, citizens police academy, school groups, philanthropic groups, etc.)

#### **Forensic Participation**

- •Participation at a minimum of five (5) forensic related professional workshops or conferences totaling at least 100 hours of training approved by the technical leader
  - and
- •Membership in a discipline specific forensic organization from the SED Director's Approved List

## **Discipline Expertise**

- •Satisfactorily proficiency tested in the applicable forensic discipline, with no level I discrepancies within the last three (3) years (according to the APD Crime Laboratory Quality Manual) <u>and</u>
- •Capable of performing completely independent casework in all respective areas of the applicable forensic discipline <u>and</u>
- •Successfully testified in a court of law in the applicable forensic discipline
