Optum Rx has a list of employees and dependents that are preapproved for medication provided by Express Scripts. These employees are grandfathered for 90 days. Please have your prescribing provider contact Optum Rx to start the approval process on your behalf.

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I have not received my Optum Rx card by mail. What do I do in the mean time to get my prescriptions?

New pharmacy cards have been sent via mail. However, if you need to fill a prescription before receiving your card, you can use the temporary card provided at the following link: <u>Temporary Pharmacy ID Card</u>. On the bottom left of the temporary card, you will find a box with the City of Albuquerque's RX Group # CABQ. When visiting the pharmacy, they will require either the employee's name or social security number (SSN) to process your prescription.

** Members can fill at any retail pharmacy within the broad network (which encompasses almost all retail pharmacies.) However, if a member has a 90-day maintenance medication, they are required to use Walgreens, Optum home delivery, or your 9 preferred local pharmacies.
