Ensuring that low-cost, no overdraft, no-surprise-fee bank and credit union accounts are an option for unbanked and underserved individuals.


The Bank On certified accounts at banks and credit unions are safe for consumers.

Core features of the Bank On certified accounts available at Bank On Burque financial institution partners includes:

- Checking Account
- Debit Card Network
- Low Monthly Maintenance Fees (\$10 or less if waivable, \$5 or less if not waivable)
- No overdraft or non-sufficient funds fees
- No low-balance or inactivity fees
- Free Direct Deposit
- Free and unrestricted ATM access (in network)



Getting Started

01 See a list of checking accounts available to you and choose a bank or credit union that best fits your needs. See the list at cabq.gov/BankOnBurque.

02 Call the bank or credit union you've selected to ask about their Bank On Burque account products. Call more than one to compare.

03 Remember to ask the bank or credit union what you need to bring for opening an account.

04 When you decide which bank or credit union you would like to open your account at, schedule an appointment.

05 Before signing for your new account, read all the terms and conditions. If there is something you don't understand, ask questions.

Never sign if you do not understand. It is always okay to ask questions.


Save Money

No more high fees to use check cashing services. For example, if you pay a 3% service charge to cash your \$1000 check, you are losing \$30.



Keep Your Money Safe

Cash can be easily lost. Reduce your chances of losing your money by only keeping what you need on hand. You can withdraw your money as you need with access to an ATM.



No Surprise Fees

Fees can sneak up on you. No more overdraft or insufficient funds charges. No more low-balance, dormancy or inactivity fees. These are core features included in these accounts.



Pay Bills Easily and Quickly

Save time by paying your bills online from your computer, tablet, or phone. Be part of a debit card network that is free to you for making electronic payments.

Several of the banks and credit unions participating in the Bank On Burque Coalition accept different forms of identification including Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN), Matricular Consular, and Tribal ID.
