ATTENTION ALBUQUERQUE YOUTH!!!

Mayor Richard J. Berry is asking youth from around the City of Albuquerque to apply to be a part of the Mayor's Youth Advisory Council! The Mayor's Youth Advisory Council (MYAC) will be responsible for advising the Mayor on issues concerning Albuquerque's youth. The MYAC will be composed of 13 members representing communities from across the City bringing the voice of our youth ages 13-18 directly to the Mayor.

As a MYAC member you may serve a one (1) or two (2) year term dependent upon your availability. The MYAC meets on the first and third Wednesday of each month at 5:00 pm, as well as occasional Sunday working meetings. Youth Council members will have an opportunity to enhance their understanding of city government through their participation on council matters. On a quarterly basis members will meet with the Mayor at City Hall to discuss youth needs, Youth Council projects, and recommend what they think the city can do to improve the lives of youth.

As a member of the Mayor's Youth Advisory Council you will:

- Advising the Mayor on City programs geared toward youth, including the need for new or expanded programs.
- Facilitating at least two "job shadow" days each year, following anyone within city government to learn more about what they do. This will enable you to learn more about City programs and possible career fields.
- Serving as the Mayor's liaison to other youth-oriented organizations.
- Developing and implement an annual public service project.
- Promoting and assist in the establishment of effective programs for the prevention of delinquency, youth crimes, crimes against youth, drug and alcohol abuse and other issues important to youth.

Applications are due no later than **5:00 p.m. March 15th**, **2013.** Applicants will be required to go through an interview and selection process and must have parent or guardian approval before applying.

The application requires the following:

- Completed short answer, and essay questions.
- Two letters of recommendation. One from a community leader and/or non-family related member of the community. Another letter of recommendation from a teacher, principle, advisor or other school faculty member.
- Résumé. You can either complete your own, or follow the template attached to the application.

Short Answer Questions: Please answer the following questions in the space provided.

- 1. The Mayor's Youth Advisory Council will meet on a bi-monthly basis during the first and third Wednesdays of each month, as well as the occasional Sunday working meeting. Would you be available to meet on those Wednesdays at 5:00 pm?
- 2. Would you be able to attend MYAC meetings using your own transportation or will you be receiving a ride from another?
- 3. Please list any personal skills or interests you have that you would like to bring the Mayor's Youth Advisory Council.

Essay Questions: Please answer the following questions below on a separate sheet of paper or word processor. Suggested length is no more than 250 words or less on a separate typed page.

- 1. How do you see the MYAC impacting the community?
- 2. List those goals you wish to accomplish most immediately after graduating from high school or within the next four (4) years. (Be specific)

- 3. Given the opportunity to influence a significant change in Albuquerque, what <u>youth-related</u> issue would you address? What approach would you take? Who would you like to work with? Why this particular issue?
- 4. What would you like to see in the city of Albuquerque over the next 25 years?


Interview

All applications are due no later than March 15th at 5:00 pm. Application review and finalist callbacks for an interview will take place by March 21st.
