- 75% complete, reveling rate structures or billing errors and opportunities to change the rate

## Next steps in Audit will be completed by late December

- > Grid Modernization Presentation/ Water Leak App (Mountain Vector Presenting)
  - Energy & Sustainability Division & MV created phone App to detect real time water leak and provide reporting on a daily basis
  - All Facility managers have a full access to monitor their water consumption
  - Total of 1.6 Million gallons of opportunity to tackle leaks around the city with this App that will save thousands of dollars.

#### Grid Modernization

The city of Albuquerque received a Grid Modernization Grant to empower the resilience of the achieving the 100% renewable goals.

- BRAIN (Balanced resource acquisition and information network was innovated as a part of the grid modernization.
- Storage, generation and controls
- Flexibility and interaction amongst centralized resources

- 4500 Utility Meters 39 MW of solar, 9 batteries, many BAS systems
- Link different software's to interact automatically
- All data in one place for easy access and better job performance
