

LIBRARY BONDS

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| Library Materials | \$2,000,000 | Purchase library materials such as books, periodicals, audio visual materials, electronic resources and other needed materials to meet customer demand for new information, replace outdated materials, and provide educational and informational materials for all libraries. |
| Library Automation | \$500,000 | Purchase and install updated automation equipment to maintain network services, automated systems and other equipment used to provide customers with access to new information, library catalogs, web based services and other electronic services. |
| Special Collection Library: Renovation / Historic Preservation | \$400,000 | Renovate and repair the Special Collections Library building to ensure that the facility is preserved and that ongoing Library services can be delivered effectively. Purchase historically appropriate furnishings and equipment. |
| Library Building Improvement | \$100,000 | Design and construct improvements, purchase related equipment and furnishings to correct critical deficiencies in City library facilities and to provide service to growing numbers of library users. Request will reduce long term maintenance cost |
| District 5, Taylor Ranch Library | \$50,000 | Design and construct ADA compliant parking spaces, and provide equipment and materials for the Taylor Ranch Library's children's room and video collection. |
| 1% for Public Art | \$31,000 | As provided in the City's "Art in Municipal Places" ordinance, one percent of each bond purpose shall be provided for Public Art. |
