

Public Safety Bonds

Apparatus Replacement	\$2,000,000	Purchase new emergency response apparatus to replace outdated equipment.
Fire Station Rehabilitation	\$500,000	Renovate and rehabilitate Albuquerque fire stations in order to maintain adequate living conditions and working facilities for emergency response personnel.
Sixth Area Command, Phase II	\$3,200,000	Design, construct, and purchase related furnishings and equipment for the Sixth Area Command in Albuquerque. The construction will be completed in two phases. The first phase will include infrastructure and ROW improvements to Ellison and Cibola Loop, in conjunction with the implementation and opening of a temporary substation at the site to be operational by early 2008. The second and final phase will consist of all remaining site improvements and construction of the permanent Command Headquarters, slated for completion the following year.
Marked Police Vehicles	\$2,500,000	Purchase marked police vehicles and equipment as required by R-07-12.
District 1, Shawn McWethy Substation	\$10,000	Design, construct, install, furnish, equip or renovate Shawn McWethy Substation.
District 7, APD Facilities Renovation / Upgrade	\$150,000	Design, construct, renovate, equip APD facilities. Improvements may include, but are not limited to, landscaping, signage, cameras, lighting, fencing and other security measures, and parking lot upgrades.
1% for Public Art	\$84,000	As provided in the City's "Art in Municipal Places" ordinance, one percent of each bond purpose shall be provided for Public Art.
