

## Library Bonds

<b>Library Materials</b>	\$2,000,000	Purchase library materials such as books, periodicals, audiovisual materials, electronic resources and other needed materials to meet customer demand for new information; replace outdated material, and provide educational and recreational materials for all libraries.
<b>Library Materials - International District Library</b>	\$250,000	Purchase multi-lingual, multi-cultural library materials, including books, periodicals, audiovisual materials, electronic resources or other needed material for a library to be located in the International District.
<b>Library Automation</b>	\$650,000	Design, purchase and install updated automation equipment to maintain network services, automated systems and other equipment.
<b>Main Library Roof Repair</b>	\$1,100,000	Plan, design, construct, repair and purchase related equipment for the roof at the Main Library.
<b>Library Building Renovation</b>	\$150,000	Design, construct, and purchase related equipment and furnishings to rehabilitate critical deficiencies in 14 City library facilities. Improve energy and water efficiency and address ADA and safety issues.
<b>Feasibility Study - Northwest Library</b>	\$100,000	Conduct a feasibility study to determine the best location for a new public library to be located on the northwest mesa. Any unused funding may be used for the development of conceptual plans for the northwest mesa library.
<b>Feasibility Study - Council District 6 Library</b>	\$100,000	Conduct a feasibility study to determine the best location for a new public library to be located in Council District 6, including evaluating possible locations in area schools. Any unused funding may be used for the development of conceptual plans for an International District library.
<b>Public Library at Central &amp; Unser</b>	\$650,000	Plan, design, construct, furnish and equip 20,000 square foot library. Purchase library materials and automation equipment.
<b>District 7, Libraries</b>	\$50,000	Equip, furnish and renovate libraries in District 7.
<b>1% for Public Art</b>	\$51,000	As provided in the City's "Art in Municipal Places" ordinance, one percent of each bond purpose shall be provided for Public Art.

**Total** **\$5,101,000**
