

Senior, Family, Community Center, and Community Enhancement Project Bonds

Renovations, Additions and Security Improvements: Existing FCSD Facilities	\$600,000	Design, renovate, demolish, construct, equip, furnish, provide security improvements and otherwise make improvements to existing FCSD facilities and sites. 100% of funding will be spent within the 1980 boundaries. None of these funds may be used for the design, construction, renovation, repair or any other related expenses for the Downtown Cultural Facility for Teens.
Holiday Park Community Center	\$1,000,000	Design, renovate, demolish, construct, equip, furnish, provide security improvements and otherwise make improvements to the Holiday Park Community Center.
Westgate CC Reconstruction	\$4,000,000	Acquire land, design, renovate, demolish, construct, equip, furnish, provide security improvements and otherwise make improvements to the existing Westgate Community Center or one at an alternate location.
Los Duranes CC Reconstruction, Phase I	\$5,000,000	Design, renovate, demolish, construct, equip, furnish, provide security improvements and otherwise make improvements to the Los Duranes Community Center.
Mesa Verde Community Center	\$1,000,000	Design, renovate, demolish, construct, equip, furnish, provide security improvements and otherwise make improvements to Mesa Verde Community Center, Phase III.
Pat Hurley Community Center	\$500,000	Plan and design additions and improvements to the Pat Hurley Community Center.
Storehouse Facility	\$1,000,000	Acquire land or property, design, demolish, construct, renovate, equip, furnish and make other improvements as necessary for a facility to be leased as a storehouse for food that will be used to reduce hunger for the homeless and near homeless residents of Albuquerque.
Renovation of Downtown Cultural Facility for Teens, Phase II	\$1,300,000	Design, renovate, demolish, construct, equip, furnish, provide security improvements and otherwise make improvements to a Downtown Cultural Facility for Teens Community Center. Phase I was completed in December 2008. This request is for the second of three phases.
Senior Center Rehabilitation	\$500,000	Design, construct, rehabilitate, and purchase related equipment for Senior Centers to improve, maintain, enhance and extend the service life of the facilities and grounds.
Bear Canyon Senior Center	\$1,000,000	Plan, design, construct, furnish, equip and otherwise improve the Bear Canyon Senior Center.

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North Domingo Baca Multigenerational Facility	\$4,000,000	Plan, design, construct, furnish, equip and otherwise improve the North Domingo Baca Multigenerational Facility.
District 1, Community / Senior Center / Neighborhood Enhancements	\$390,000	Design, construct, install and renovate improvements for Community and Senior Centers in District 1.
District 2, Public Facilities	\$300,000	Plan, design, construct, install and renovate public facilities.
District 2, Economic Development	\$100,000	Plan, design or construct economic development improvements in Council District 2.
District 3, Community / Senior Center / Neighborhood Enhancements	\$100,000	Equip, repair, and design, install, replace and construct improvements at community centers, senior centers, and neighborhood facilities in District 3.
District 4, North Domingo Baca Multigenerational Center	\$750,000	Design, construct, equip, furnish, install equipment and furnishings, improve, and enhance the North Domingo Baca Multigenerational Center.
District 6, Community / Senior Center / Neighborhood Enhancements	\$100,000	Design, construct, rehabilitate and install improvements for Community and Senior Centers in District 6.
District 7, Community / Senior Center / Neighborhood Enhancements	\$20,000	Replace and install equipment in senior centers. Equipment may include, but is not limited to kilns and ovens.
District 8, Community / Senior Center / Neighborhood Enhancements	\$600,000	Design, install, construct, equip, furnish or renovate community and senior centers and community enhancement projects for the benefit of Council District 8.
District 9, Community / Senior Center / Neighborhood Enhancements	\$250,000	Design, install, construct, acquire land or rights-of-way for, equip, furnish or renovate community and senior centers and community enhancement projects for the benefit of Council District 9.
1% for Public Art	\$226,000	As provided in the City's "Art in Municipal Places" ordinance, one percent of each bond purpose shall be provided for Public Art.
