

## Public Safety Bonds

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<b>Fire Apparatus Replacement</b>	\$3,875,000	Purchase and replace emergency response apparatus, including but not limited to Fire Engines, Ladder Trucks, Hazmat Rescue Vehicles and Brush Trucks.
<b>Fire Station 13 Renovations</b>	\$175,000	To plan, design, construct, equip, repair, and renovate Fire Station 13 including but not limited to HVAC systems and roof replacement.
<b>Fire Station Rehabilitation</b>	\$750,000	Plan, design, construct and renovate Fire Department Facilities.
<b>Marked and Unmarked Vehicle Replacement</b>	\$2,000,000	Funding will be used to purchase marked and unmarked vehicles that meet obsolescence standards or that are damaged due to accidents.
<b>APD Facility Repair and Renovation</b>	\$1,500,000	Plan, design, construct and renovate existing APD facilities.
<b>Comprehensive Information Systems Project (CISP)</b>	\$1,975,000	Replace and/or upgrade the existing 700mhz data delivery system; add wireless access points that allows officers to access the COA local area network; and design and implement wireless corridors in high-traffic areas.
<b>District 1, Public Safety Projects</b>	\$50,000	Study, design, develop, construct, modernize, automate, rehabilitate, landscape, furnish, enhance and otherwise improve, and acquire land, buildings, vehicles, apparatus and equipment for police and fire department facilities that benefit District 1.
<b>District 7, Public Safety Projects</b>	\$125,000	Study, design, develop, construct, modernize, automate, rehabilitate, landscape, furnish, enhance and otherwise improve, and acquire land, buildings, vehicles, apparatus and equipment for fire department facilities that benefit District 7.
<b>1% for Public Art</b>	\$105,000	As provided in the City's "Art in Municipal Places" ordinance, one percent of each bond purpose shall be provided for Public Art.
