Welcome and Introductions

Dan Majewski welcomed everyone and asked the committee, staff, and audience to identify themselves.

Approval of Agenda

Dan motioned to amend the agenda to add Wayne Inniss' presentation; it was unanimous.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Dan motioned to approve the October 2019 minutes; it was unanimous.

Presentations

Wayne Inniss – Presented on the future of e-bike use and their growing popularity. Mr. Inniss noted that there is currently confusion between different agencies on the regulation of e-bikes on trails and open space areas. There is also confusion about on definition of signs saying No Motorized Vehicles - is an e-bike considered motorized? Request to push legislation for a 3-tier e-bike category system.

Karen Iverson – Rail Trail Project: Just completed the planning phase for a multi-use trail from Central to Lomas with road and crossing improvements @ Marquette/Tijeras. The trail is proposed to have a 13' path requiring 25' of right of way. Development of the trail hopes to encourage a sports tourism package, which will require additional funding. The Metropolitan Redevelopment Agency have not met with the Rail Bureau yet since the project is still conceptual.


