Museum, Zoo and Biological Park, and Cultural Facility Bonds

Balloon Museum Exhibit Development

\$200,000 Plan, design, modify and install exhibits that inform the public of lighter-than-air flight. This request allows for the acquisition of equipment, furniture, fixtures and display objects that will be integrated into exhibits aligned with the Balloon Museum's educational mission. There will be a specific focus on planning, development and acquisition of fun, interactive displays that engage visitors and encourage repeat visits. Ongoing exhibit development through October 2017.

Casa San Ysidro

\$200,000 Plan, design, & construct a visitor's center, plaza, & parking lot at Casa San Ysidro, on the State's Historic Register, & purchase related equipment. Correct ADA deficiencies & provide a facility that meets standards for accreditation. Provides for rehabilitation of visitor restrooms, staff offices (to be removed from the Historic house), school tour orientation/exhibition gallery, collection storage, parking, & plaza area for educational events while preserving the historic facility & artifacts. Final project completion is expected by 2022, contingent on future funding.

Renovation & Repair (BioPark)

\$3,500,000 Plan, design, construct, equip, furnish and renovate outdated facilities to include utilities, life support, animal enclosures, public amenities, electronic equipment and landscaping. Remodel existing outdated facilities at the BioPark Facilities include Zoo. Aguarium, Botanic Garden and Tingley Beach.

1% for Public Art

\$40,000 As provided in the City's "Art in Municipal Places" ordinance, one percent of each bond purpose shall be provided for Public Art.
