Background

The City of Albuquerque's past investments in field technology for APD have improved the efficiency and capacity of our field officers as they respond to violent crimes. For example, expansions in gunshot detection technology have enabled faster response times, more felony arrests, and the recovery of many stolen firearms. Between January and September 2023, over 10,000 alerts were detected by existing ShotSpotter technologies across the City of Albuquerque, resulting in arrests of violent criminals.

This request will help the City of Albuquerque to create a crime-fighting grid within the metro area, including cameras on arterial roads, gunshot detection technology expansion, and license plate readers throughout the City. This initiative would be designed to seamlessly integrate with the Real Time Crime Center to support law enforcement officers as they respond to violent crimes. Albuquerque is requesting the state to invest \$20 mil
