Background

The City of Albuquerque is seeking funding to implement a master plan for land acquisition, trail improvements, signage, Singing Arrow archaeological site development, and Tijeras Arroyo habitat restoration.

This funding request will enable the City to plan and design a site plan and construct an educational facility for the Tijeras Biological Zone Education Center. Improvements at the recently-acquired 25-acre property that will provide a prime visitor access point and trailhead to Tijeras Canyon, as well as a small campground to introduce children and families to nature and overnight camping. It will also support upgrades to electric and water infrastructure, restore the Tijeras Arroyo, and establish a visitor education contact station.
