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<sup>1</sup> Elections shall be conducted in the following order. Board members who are interested in running for 2025 Chair will be encouraged to volunteer themselves and board members may also nominate another board member. Any nominations, including self-nominations, require a second by another board member to be considered. Once the nominations are made and seconded, the board will either conduct a roll call vote stating the name of the candidate they are voting for. If there is only one candidate nominated, the roll call vote will be to approve (aye) or not approve (no) the lone candidate. Once a quorum of the board elects/approves a candidate, the candidate becomes the Board Chair Elect for 2025. The process will be repeated for the Vice Chair Position. The 2025 Board Chair Elect may not run for the 2025 Board Vice Chair position. Current officers may run for a 2<sup>nd</sup> term in the same position, or for the 1<sup>st</sup> term in the election for the position that they did not hold in 2024. No incumbent may run for a 3<sup>rd</sup> year in the same position, and members who’s term is concluding on 12/31/2024 may not run unless they have been approved by City Council to remain on the board for an additional 3 year term.
