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NORTHEAST AREA COMMAND **COMMUNITY POLICING COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2014-(1)**

NOTICE REQUIREMENTS FOR MEETINGS OF THE COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque ("City") Northeast Area Command 6 Community Policing Council (Council) met in regular session at the North Domingo 7 8 Baca Multigenerational Center, 7521 Carmel NE Albuquerque, NM 87113, on November 17 at 6:30 PM as required by law; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(B) (NMSA 1978) of the Open Meetings Act states 10 that "[A]ll meetings of a quorum of members of any board, commission, administrative 11 adjudicatory body or other policymaking body of any state agency, any agency or 12 authority of any county, municipality, district or any political subdivision, held for the 13 purpose of formulating public policy, including the development of personnel policy, 14 rules, regulations or ordinances, discussing public business or for the purpose of taking 15 any action within the authority of or the delegated authority of any board, commission or 16 17 other policymaking body are declared to be public meetings open to the public at all times except as may be otherwise provided in the Constitution of New Mexico, or the 18 provisions of the Open Meetings Act;" and 19

WHEREAS, any meetings subject to the Open Meetings Act at which the 20 discussion or adoption of any proposed resolution, rule, regulation or formal action 21 occurs shall be held only after reasonable notice to the public; and 22

23	WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(D) of the Open Meetings Act requires the Council
24	to determine annually what constitutes reasonable notice of its public meetings; and
25	WHEREAS, Section 2-6-1-4(B) (ROA 1994) of the City of Albuquerque Public
26	Boards, Commissions and Committees Ordinance requires that every public board,
27	commission or committee created by the City of Albuquerque must determine what is
28	reasonable notice to the public of its meetings; provided that in no event shall notice be
29	less than the notice required for Albuquerque City Council meetings;
30 31 32	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE NORTHEAST AREA COMMAND COMMUNITY POLICING COUNCIL, that:
33	Section 1. Unless otherwise specified, all meetings of the Council shall be held at
34	North Domingo Baca Multigenerational Center, 7521 Carmel NE Albuquerque, NM
35	87113
36	Section 2. Unless otherwise specified, regularly scheduled meetings of the
37	Council shall be held on <u>Znewsday of Month</u> . Public notice in writing of any
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	other regularly scheduled meetings will be given at least five (5) days in advance of the

Section 3. Special meetings of the Council may be called by the Chairperson of
the Council or by a majority of the Council members upon three (3) days advance notice.
The agenda for a special meeting will be available to the public at least seventy two (72)
hours prior to such special meeting. Copies of the agenda will be available to the public
upon request from the Director of the Office of Diversity and Human Rights, whose
phone number is 505-768-4712 and whose office is located in the Albuquerque/Bernalillo
County Government Center Building at 1 Civic Plaza NW, Albuquerque, NM 87102.

Section 4. Emergency meetings of the Council will be called only under 52 53 unforeseen circumstances that demand immediate action by the Council to protect the health, safety and property of citizens or to protect the public body from substantial 54 55 financial loss. The Council will avoid holding emergency meetings whenever possible. 56 Emergency meetings may be called by the Chairperson or a majority of the Council 57 members upon twenty-four (24) hours notice, unless threat of personal injury or property 58 damage requires less notice. Public notice for an emergency meeting shall include an agenda for the emergency meeting. 59

60 Section 5. For all meetings described in this resolution, public notice 61 requirements are met if:

62 63 A. a printed notice of the date, time and place of the meeting is posted for public viewing in the following location: in the 1st floor lobby of the Albuquerque/Bernalillo

- County Government Center (City-County Building) at 1 Civic Plaza NW, Albuquerque,
 NM 87102 and
- B. an electronic copy of the notice is posted on the Council web page. Currently,
 the Council web page address is <u>http://www.cabq.gov/mayor/</u> and this website address
 may change from time to time as needed by the City or the Council.
- C. Notice shall also be sent electronically to those broadcast stations (radio and 69 70 television) licensed by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and newspapers of general circulation in the State of New Mexico that (i) have submitted a written 71 request for notice of public meetings to the Office of Diversity and Human Rights, whose 72 73 office is located in the Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Government Center Building at 1 74 Civic Plaza NW, Albuquerque, NM 87102, and (ii) have provided an electronic mail (email) address to which public notices are to be sent. Currently, the Council finds that the 75 76 Office of Diversity and Human Rights has not received any written requests for ongoing notice of all Council meetings from any FCC licensed broadcast stations or from 77 78 newspapers of general circulation, located in New Mexico or anywhere else.
- Section 6. In addition to the information specified above, all public notices shall
 include the following language:
- "NOTICE TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES: If you are a person with a disability
 and require a reasonable accommodation to observe or participate in this meeting, please
 contact Ms. Shannon Triplett, whose phone number is 505-768-4712 and whose email

address is: <u>odhr@cabq.gov</u> as soon as possible. Public documents, including the agenda
and minutes, can be provided in various accessible formats. Please contact the office if a
summary or other type of accessible format is needed. The meeting will occur in a room
that is accessible to persons in wheelchairs, by use of an elevator."

Section 7. Notice of Cancellations of meetings of the Council, and notice of 88 89 different meeting times and/or dates and/or locations, may be announced at prior meetings of the Council. Sudden cancellations of meetings may occur if a quorum of 90 Council members cannot or unexpected fail to attend a previously scheduled meeting 91 92 time. Different meeting dates and times may be needed if a regularly scheduled meeting date (such as a Monday) is a federal, state or city holiday and City offices are closed that 93 day. And different meeting dates and/or times and/or locations may be needed for a 94 regularly scheduled meeting date if there is inclement weather, or if the meeting location 95 is not available for use, or for other reasons. 96

97 Section 8. Notice of committee meetings, if any committees are formed, shall be
98 equal to that specified in Sections 2 and 3 of this resolution.

99 Section 9. The Council may close a Meeting of the Council to the public only if
100 the subject matter of such discussion or action is exempted from the open to the public
101 meeting requirement under Section 10-15- 1(H) (NMSA 1978) of the Open Meetings
102 Act.

A. If any open meeting is closed during such open meeting, the closure shall be 103 104 approved by a majority vote of a quorum of the Council taken during the open meeting. 105 The specific provision of law authorizing the closed meeting and the subject(s) to be discussed shall be stated with reasonable specificity in the motion to close the meeting to 106 public observation and the vote of each individual member on the motion to close the 107 meeting shall be recorded in the minutes, in a roll call vote. Only those subjects specified 108 in the motion to close the meeting may be discussed by the Council in the closed 109 meeting. 110

B. If a closed meeting is conducted when the Council is not in an open meeting, the closed meeting shall not be held until a written public notice of the meeting of the Council, appropriate under the circumstances, stating the specific provision of law authorizing the closed meeting and the subjects to be discussed with reasonable specificity, is given to Council members and to the public.

116 C. Following completion of any closed meeting, the minutes of the open meeting 117 that was closed, or the minutes of the next open meeting of the Council if the closed 118 meeting was separately scheduled, shall state whether the matters discussed in the closed 119 meeting were limited only to those specified in the motion to close the meeting or the 120 public notice of a closed meeting. D. Except as provided in Section 10-15-1(H) (NMSA 1978) of the Open Meetings Act, any action taken as a result of discussions in a closed meeting shall be made by a public vote of the Council in an open meeting.

- 124 Section 10. All resolutions, rules or parts of resolutions or rules, inconsistent with 125 this resolution, are hereby repealed only to the extent of such inconsistency. Such 126 implied repeal shall not be construed to revive any resolution, rule or part of any 127 resolution or rule that was previously repealed.
- 128 Section 11. The Regular Meetings of the Northeast Area Command Community 129 Policing Council from November 2014 to October 2015 will occur on the 130 2^{n} Tresday of the north

131 Section 12. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase of this 132 resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent 133 jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this 134 resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and 135 each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase of this resolution irrespective of 136 any provision being declared invalid or unenforceable.
