Jerry Cline Recreation and Tennis Center
7205 Constitution NE (505-224-6682)

This facility consists of 18 tennis courts; thirteen are lighted. You may reserve the courts by phone or in person. Reservations are

taken two days in advance beginning at 8:00 am. On Thursdays, reservations may be made for both Saturday and Sunday. A ball machine is available for \$8 per court hour. Feel free to call for current hours of operation. See below for court rates.

Sierra Vista West Tennis Complex **5001 Montañó NW (505-897-8815)**

This complex consists of 10 courts and a swimming pool. The reservation policy for Sierra Vista is the same as Jerry Cline. Sierra Vista has a ball machine as well. Court and ball machine charges are the same. Both sites offer a variety of programs including instruction, leagues, junior development, novice groups, tournaments, and drop-in tennis. What is the Drop-in Tennis League?

It is an informal, friendly tennis league sponsored by the City of Albuquerque and run by the Jerry Cline Recreation and Tennis Facility and the Sierra Vista Tennis Center. A minimum intermediate skill is required, as determined by the Drop-In Coordinator. Juniors are generally not permitted, but an occasional

exception may be made. Tennis balls are provided. Arrive early to insure a spot. The cost for all Drop-In sessions is \$3 per person.

Drop-In at the Jerry Cline Recreation and Tennis Facility

Morning Drop-In (Monday - Thursday): Players begin arriving before 9:00 a.m. Sign in starts at 9:00 a.m. from the beginning of October through May. From June – September, sign in will start at 8:00 a.m. The last to arrive may have to begin with singles or the ball machine, or may not get in at all, so arrive early to insure your spot. Players have a choice of playing up to three rounds.

Evening Drop-In (Mondays and Wednesdays, 6 p.m.): The first round begins as players arrive on a **first come first serve basis**. Players have the choice to play one round until 6:40 p.m., two rounds to 7:15 p.m., or three rounds until 8 p.m.

Drop-In at the Sierra Vista Tennis Center

Sunday morning only: Start time is 9:00 a.m. (limited courts, first come first serve basis).
