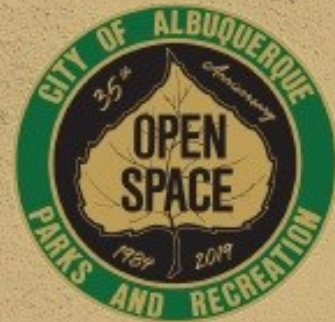


Open Space Service Day Events
