




# PUBLIC NOTICE



The City of Albuquerque's Open Space Division and its partners are undertaking a habitat restoration project in this area. The purpose of this project is to restore habitat for the benefit of the endangered Silvery Minnow.

Habitat restoration entails the creation of ephemeral channels that provide sites for egg retention and the development of minnow larvae during periods of high river flows. These channels and their subsequent revegetation have the secondary benefit of providing improved habitat for the endangered Southwestern Willow Flycatcher as well.

During the course of this project, expect heavy equipment to utilize the routes highlighted in red on this map at any time. Please use caution and be alert at all times while you are in the area.
