Proposed Program and Site Uses

PUBLIC USE

- OPEN-AIR EDUCATION CENTER for hands-on demonstrations and workshops to support the research, restoration and operations of the Rio Grande Tree Nursery and Candelaria Nature Preserve. This flexible use space would accommodate small groups in a variety of engagement opportunities.
- **GROUP GATHERING AREAS** with shade structures, site furnishings, and interpretive signage.
- **PEDESTRIAN PATHWAYS** connecting gathering areas, horticultural use areas, and site entrances.
- ACCESSIBLE CONNECTION to a pedestrian bridge over the Duranes Lateral to wildlife viewing areas and the Candelaria North Tract.

HORTICULTURE & PROPAGATION

- ARBORETUM AND TREE FIELD: The south side of the site would become an arboriculture research and demonstration field. A select number of the existing trees that are healthy and too large to transplant will remain. A variety of new trees will be cultivated to study appropriate species to use throughout Albuquerque.
- **PROPOSED HERITAGE ORCHARD*** with a variety of fruit and nut trees.
- PROPOSED COTTONWOOD GENOTYPE RESEARCH* grove and pole planting source field.
- RESTORATION PLANTING SOURCE
 FIELD to propagate seed for use in the
 Candelaria Nature Preserve.
- RESEARCH PLANTINGS for New
 Mexico Ecozones
- NATIVE GRASS MEADOW for visitor use and seed sourcing.

CIRCULATION & OPERATIONS

- **30-SPACE (APPROX.) PARKING LOT** including paved accessible spaces.
- SCHOOL BUS PARKING for two buses.
- SECURE OPERATIONS YARD for equipment and materials used in the management of the Rio Grande Tree Nursery.
- **PERIMETER SCREENING** through berms and vegetation.
- **TIME-LOCKED GATES** at vehicle and pedestrian entrances.
- PUBLIC RESTROOM

* Specific horticultural programs will be determined at a later date. These are proposals under consideration.






Do you walk regularly along the Duranes Lateral? 37 responses



Can you see the Tree Nursery Tract from your home? 37 responses




Do you anticipate using this new open space when it is complete? 37 responses


In which concept do you like the entry road, circulation, and parking layout? (Check as many as apply.)


In which concept do you like the location of the operations and storage yard? (Check as many as apply.)




In which concept do you like the location of the operations access road? (Check as many as apply.)



In which concept do you like the arrangement of the community gathering/meadow space? (Check as many as apply.) 34 responses





In which concept do you like the arrangement of the educational center? (Check as many as apply.)


Do you prefer that the pedestrian entrance to the site along Rio Grande Blvd be separate from the vehicular entrance?
