Personnel Updates

Henry Rodarte Reported:

- (3) Equipment Operators for ADO, Ladera and Puerto to be Interviewed
- (2) Irrigation Techs to be interviewed for ADO and Puerto

Rounds and Revenue

Gabriel Moreno:

FY21 just ended June 2021, monthly comparison each month was down, rounds and revenue both down. Completing FY21 we were up 32% in rounds, 31% in green revenue, 33% in pass revenue, 31% in total revenue vs. FY20.

Concessionaire Comments

Mark McFall: Reported he understands a new pump was installed and mentioned staff has been working hard. Mark went on to say the course was looking brown and hopefully the pump is the solution to the problem. Mark asked Henry if he heard correctly that PDS will be getting two new staff members, Henry confirmed yes, an Irrigator and an Equipment Operator, Henry also responded to Marks comment that yes, the motor will help but it will not be an overnight process but in time. Mark talked about keeping the night range open longer and was great full as weather has been good for it

Golf Advisory Board (GAB) Member Comments

Mark Holman: Reported that course was almost dead and went on to say the pump was improperly procured. Mark stated the course was only being watered at 30% capacity and most of course was dead, even the chick weed is dying. Mark asked should Alpha SW compensate the City and that there are only three on staff, more workers would be nice. Mark said it was hard to know who to blame for the pump purchase. Mark said the Association had just spent \$900-\$1000 on seed and asked if PDS can be a priority and stated again that the chick weed is dying and that hopefully more help is coming.

Karla: Recognized, Deputy Director David Flores chiming into the meeting, David said he was just listening in and thanked the Board Members for participating.

Chris Grover: Did not have anything to report

Tommy Borst: Reported he had played Ladera the previous day and the course was good, he went on to say that there were several areas marked off ground under repair for the Men's City Tournament. Tommy went on to ask about the granite markers on the Executive course as he does not play there much. Henry responded that Vince was looking into an adhesive and he believed they had been repaired but will confirm. Tommy stated he understood Ladera had gotten a new hole puncher, Henry advised that the new greens aerator was for all courses and that all aeration equipment is shared.

Denise Foor: Reported she was out of town last meeting as asked Henry if she heard correctly that ADO was getting a new Irrigator? She talked about noticing on the back 9 on either hole 14 or 15 that there is sitting water. She said she had played the Dam 9 the previous week and there was standing water behind 7 green. Denise stated there had been no problems reported from the 18-hole group and that she had played the Los Altos Exec. and it was good and that she had not played the Los Altos 18 in a while. Denise said her only concern was the irrigation for Arroyo.

Dan Hedges: Asked a question about JR golfers; Is there a minimum age? Henry was not certain and asked Gabe if he knew, Gabe said he was unsure and would have to defer the question to Dave. Henry to look into it.

Karla Degroft: Not much to say, Los Altos in great shape. Karla mentioned she also plays Ladera and had sent out an email that there were no silver tee markers on the shared tees. Henry responded and advised he had spoken with Assistant Supervisor Chris Ornales and he would address it. Mark Holman chimed back in asking if there is a plan for PDS to bring it back? Henry responded, he and Dave would assess and make a plan.

Henry came back and said he had confirmed that 12+ years of age for JR's to play without an adult.
