Personnel Updates

Dave Salas reported:

- o M14 Supervisor Los Altos/ADO interviewed on June 14, 2023.
- B20 Golf Maintenance worker ad closes on June 19, 2023. Previous candidate declined position.
- o B32 General Maintenance worker will start July 1, 2023.
- o B26 Utility Worker will start July 1, 2023.
- o PDS Equipment Mechanic will close today July15,2023

Dave stated the future projects are:

Capital Outlay -

- o LD Plan and design of: 525k
 - Final design completed for the Cantina, work to be started soon.
 - Electrical al LD to gazebo, work to be started soon.
 - New exit door at LD Proshop to be started soon
 - 525k will cover cantina
 - Cost estimates for the night range lighting
- o PDS Plan and design of: 100k
 - Building improvements are on hold
 - Outdoor seating plans have begun waiting on architect
 - Movement in planning on outdoor seating
- Los Altos plan and design of: 50k
 - Outdoor seating improvements no movement
 - Still in Planning no movement

GO Bond 1M

- o Current Projects:
 - o PDS soil and water amendments have been started.
 - o PDS has started to evaluate the wet areas and cart paths.
 - o Golf App Status active still unable to use due to technical difficulties.
 - Validation of City Passes on hold due to IT bug -Noted that 2/3 of yearly passes were not in database so many were playing on expired passes. Expired passes are no longer valid, so golfers are buying them again. A backup list has been created and will be incorporated once the IT bug is fixed.

- RFP is out and closed February 10, 2023. CDK is awarded PDS. No recommendation yet to ADO. June 5, 2023 is the end of public comments.
- Projects on hold
 - Intrusion Alarms ADO, LA and PDS. ADO and LA and PDS wired, waiting on phone lines for PDS and LA. ADO and PDS complete, system installed just waiting on phone line for monitoring. DTI is working on getting phone number message to work correctly.

Rounds and Revenue

Gabe Moreno reported:

May 2023 Info for the June 15th Golf Advisory Board Meeting at Los Altos Golf Course

For monthly comparisons from April 2023 to May 2023 we were up 9.83% or 2,712 rounds, up 12.03% or \$53,605 in green fee revenue, up 50.92% or \$45,479 in pass revenue, and up 18.53% or \$99,084 in total revenue.

Comparing FY23 to FY22, we are still down -4.02% or -9,155 rounds, down -1.71% or -\$60,625 in green fee revenue, up 0.98% or \$4,236 in pass revenue, resulting in us being down overall -1.41% or -\$56,390 in total revenue.

For FY23 Golf Revenue as of May 31^{st} was \$ 4,928,520.90 minus Expenses of \$ 5,076,168.97 = \$ 147,648.07 net loss.

<u>June 2023 Info for the upcoming July 20th Golf Advisory Board Meeting at the Golf Management Office</u>

For monthly comparisons from May 2023 to June 2023 we were up 8.70% or 2,630 rounds, up 11.72% or \$59,159 in green fee revenue, down -94.51% or \$43,400 in pass revenue, and up 2.86% or \$15,759 in total revenue.

Comparing FY23 year end to FY22 year end, we finished down -2.40% or -6,183 rounds, finished up 0.54% or -\$21,721 in green fee revenue, finished up 1.38% or \$6,616 in pass revenue, resulting in us finishing up overall 0.62% or \$28,338 in total revenue.

For FY23 Golf Revenue as of June 30^{th} was \$ 5,512,597.43 minus Expenses of \$ 5,451,738.54 = \$ 60,858.89 net profit.

NOTE: Net Profit/Loss Amount is estimated since Journal Entries are needed the following month after month end to correctly adjust COA and Concessionaire percentage splits.

Golf Course

Arroyo Del Oso issues:

1. Denise is going to talk to The Woman's league a week prior to the GAB meeting to get input and hole #3. Woman league still wants it to be recalculated to be a par 5. Score card doesn't

match the Ghin. Tony spoke to Sun Country and asked that it be changed back to a par 5. Denise will call Sun Country 505-390-9890

- 2.. The right side of #17 & #18 is a lateral penalty area. Tony said the score cards are incorrect. Will ask Tony to put something up about the local rules.
- 3. Aprons around the greens have been bad. Pumps were down so needing to be over seeded but not until next FY24.
- 4. Henry will speak to Crystal about a water bucket on the #10 ADO.

Ladera issues:

- 1. Sanitation Project is starting June 14, 2023 and run until November 2023. They will start on the fairway on #9. Map attached started June 14, 2023.
- 2. #13 still needs the fairway recontoured on the west rough. Will ask Vince to work on contouring the fairway sometime in September due to the weather.
- 3. Brass button is currently dormant and will spot spray. Need to speak to Vince

Puerto Del Sol issues:

- 1. Lightning detector needs to be replaced due to outdated/obsolete. Manual only and cannot connect to weather systems.
- 2. Parking lot needs resurfacing due to ponding after rain. No funding.
- 3. Higher fence behind driving range/ possible signage. 50-yard fence to protect from the driving range #4 green #5 tee box.
- 5. Chick weed spraying need to be consistent #8 right side needs more spraying.
- 6. The special grass seed the organization bought, was it spread? Dave will follow up with John. John stated he was doing a cover crop with the bent grass to rye grass combination.
- 7. Irrigation/system issues on #4 and #9 are still ongoing and have been for years. According to John, the irrigation has been worked on #9 is working great.
- 8. CDK will take over October 1, 2023. The City will run PDS from July 1 2023.
- 9. Golf carts will be allowed in parking lot.
- 10. Top dressing came out nice. Greens look better and fairways look better.
- 11. Need non-obsolete sprinkler heads and new irrigation.
- 12. Love the new striping in the parking lot and wants to thank the City and Accustripe. Concessionaire Comments: Todd Kersting
- 1. Free golf clinic July 7, 2023 open for all public with prizes to give away to get the public involved.
- 2. Article in paper journal, nicely written about the taco food trucks and night range.

Los Altos issues:

- 1. Push/add boulders closer that restrict cart traffic behind #18 green going to the club house.
- 2. Post emergent on #10 and brass button needs to be treated on all the greens.
- 3. fountain at #5 Tee Box is broken the fountain on Tee Box #15 works.
- 4. Pot hole in-between 7-8 on path.

Concessionaire Report - Colby Reddoch

1. New greens mower at LA.

- 2. Our new range machine at LA is up and working. Customers will now be printed out a pin number to use at the machine to get their range balls instead of having to carry them across the parking lot. Also, soon we will have range cards available that they can use at the machine. They will be given a balance of range balls they can purchase on the card at a discounted price.
- 3. Junior Golf Program update We have our summer junior camps currently taking place for 9 weeks (every Tue., Wed., Thurs.). As well we have PGA Junior League going the months of June and July.
- 4. I have been getting a lot of feedback that the course is in great shape, and the greens are rolling very well.

Barbara Lail Senior Representative - written report via email

Karla mentioned to Barbara Tuesday everyone is happy course in great shape. Need work on cart path at green on Hole #6 as well as the one at Tee box #3, as a project with a completion date, say 2 months? PDS.

The rest of the course is recovering nicely and I had comments about appreciation for the staff.
