

The first post-construction avian survey of 2015 for the Rio Grande Valley State Park Central to Montañó Project was conducted on May 7th on Phase 1, which transects closest to Central Avenue on both sides of the river.

In total, 37 species were identified at the six transects (3 on each side of the river) that were surveyed.
