# WHAT ARE SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS (SFHA) ALSO KNOWN AS FLOOD ZONES

### **Zone Types**

"X": A flood that has a 0.2% chance of being equaled or exceeded in any given year. Also known as the 500 year flood. This area has a low to moderate chance of flooding. The purchase of flood insurance as a condition for granting a loan is not required but encouraged. One to four unit buildings are eligible for the Preferred Risk Policy (usually a discounted rate) if flood insurance is purchased voluntarily.

### "X protected by Levee":

Same as zone "X", just a designation that the area is being protected by a levee. If the levee's were not present, the designation would change to one of the SFHA's listed below.

"A": High flood risk area. No Base Flood Elevation (BFE) or flood depths given. Building in this area is not allowed, unless a hydraulic analysis of the area is derived by a Professional Engineer and a BFE is provided. **The purchase of flood insurance is required as a condition of the mortgage.** 

## SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS (SFHA) CONTINUED

### Zone Types


"AH": Areas of shallow flooding, consists of ponding one (1) to three (3) feet in depth. Base Flood Elevation's (BFE) are established in relation to a national datum. The purchase of flood insurance is required as a condition of the mortgage.

"AO": Areas of sheet flow on sloping terrain, one (1) to three (3) feet in depth. BFE's are given based on feet above grade. **The purchase of flood insurance is required as a condition of the mortgage.** 


"AE": Areas of floodways, such as ravines', arroyos', pathway's, BFE's are established. The purchase of flood insurance is required as a condition of the mortgage.
