Community Interaction/involvement


- Reach out to the Mexican and Asian communities to get more integration. (outreach)

Land Use


- Encourage residents to shop in the neighborhood and support local businesses instead of going to Walmart. (Neighborhood Association)

MU 1.4 Create opportunities through zoning and design guidelines for Mixed Use development which is sensitive to the existing mixed land use pattern of multi-family and heavy commercial uses.
