Strengths:

Location: Close to resources, base, airport, downtown.

<u>Community</u>: People, families, neighborhood association, churches, temples Infrastructure: Schools, health care, community center, MR designation, extra trash pick up.

<u>Transportation</u>: Bus system.

Weaknesses:

<u>Community:</u> Absentee landlords, trash/furniture dumping, community messy, not enough case managers, pan handling.

<u>Infrastructure:</u> Lack of lighting, APD not involved in community, lack of code enforcement.

Zoning/Land Use: Rundown trailer parks, McDonalds run down, underutilized commercial land.

<u>Transportation:</u> Unmaintained medians, unsafe sidewalks, speeding, cut through traffic.

Opportunities:

<u>Community:</u> Landlord/tenant coop, work together to deal with landlord issues, more accessible social services.

<u>Infrastructure:</u> Develop and reprogram Phil Chacon park.

Zoning/land use: International language school at Caesar Chavez.

<u>Transportation:</u> beautify medians, develop programs to work with residents to fix sidewalks.

Challenges:

<u>Community:</u> Lack of community involvement, getting landlords to assume responsibility. No visible result from community efforts - disheartened community, limited community investment.
