

CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE CODE ENFORCEMENT DIVISION APPLICATION FOR VACANT BUILDING REGISTRATION

The City of Albuquerque Housing Code Ordinance requires the registration of certain buildings that are about to become vacant or are vacant per Council Bill number O-04-34 Enactment number 0-2004-045.

A vacant building is defined as follows: An apartment house, dwelling, dwelling unit, efficiency dwelling unit, habitable space, residential building, rooming house or structure lacking the continuous habitual presence of human beings who have a legal right to be on the premises for a period of 60 days or longer.

Buildings under a listing agreement with a licensed real estate agent or commercial buildings with no residential uses are excluded.

NOTE: This registration is valid for one year only and needs to be renewed each year the building is vacant.
