- IDO Section 14-16-4-3(E)(2)(e): An incidental storage area is allowed outside of the fully enclosed portions of a building, but must be screened from view from each property line as described in Subsection 14-16-5-6(G) (Screening of Mechanical Equipment and Support Areas).
- IDO Section 14-16-4-3(E)(2)(f): An odor control plan, approved by the City, is required pursuant to Subsection 14-16-6-5(G) (Site Plan – Administrative), Subsection 14-16-6-6(I) (Site Plan – DRB), or Subsection 14-16-6-6(J) (Site Plan – EPC), as relevant.
- IDO Section 14-16-4-3(E)(2)(g): In any Mixed-use zone district, this use shall not exceed 10,000 square feet of gross floor area, and all activities shall be conducted within the fully enclosed portions of a building.
