



 Monument




West Side Growth & Traffic

Development Vision

- Major Activity Center (recommended by Rank II WSSP Volcano Mesa Amendment)
 - ~ 2 million square feet of retail + office uses = ~ 5,500 jobs
- High-density Residential
 - \sim <5,000 dwelling units = \sim 13,000 residents
 - ~350 Single-family
 - ~300 Townhouse
 - ~4,000 Multifamily






VHSDP Strategy 4: Land Use & Transportation

Access Modifications

- New intersections on limitedaccess Paseo & Unser to create:
 - "Loop road" around busy intersection
 - Transit corridor to accommodate Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)
 - Mandatory street grid to disperse regional traffic and serve local development
- Metropolitan Transportation Board (MTB) Resolution to grant access









Right-in / Right-out in FAABS












Land Use & Transportation Congested Regional Traffic Forecast




Figure 1-13 Daily & Peak Hour Trip Comparison


