B-A. Responsibilitiesy

Upon confirmation of victim(s) by responding Department personnel, who is trapped on in a flood control channel, which are trapped in the channel by water build-uphigh water levels, the following procedures shawill be initiated: Department personnel shall keep citizens away from the flood control channel and stop people from attempting unauthorized rescue attempts.

- b. The An Emergency Communications Center (ECC) Dispatcher shall dispatches officers. Department personnel to the spotter/prearranged checkpoints.; and
- a. <u>ECC personnel shall</u> Department personnel <u>sha</u>will keep citizens away from the flood control channel and stop people from attempting unauthorized rescue attempts.
- c. The ECC-secures the frequency A frequency shawill be secured by the Communications CenterECC for the purpose of coordinating the rescue between personnel involved in the incident.
- 2. Responding Department presonnel who respond to the incident shall initiate the following procedures:
 - a. Confirm whetherif the victim (s) is are trapped in a flood control channel or arroyo based on y high water levels;
 - b. It is the responsibility of all Department personnel involved in the rescue precedure to a Act as spotters of the victim's (s) location and direction of travel in the flood control channels or arroyo, and shall relaying this information to the ECC and/or their supervisor; and
 - c. Department personnel shall kKeep citizens community members who are observing the incident away from the flood control channel or arroyo and stop them people from attempting an unauthorized rescue-attempts.:
