#### Crime Stats Disclaimer


The Albuquerque Police Department reports is crime statistics using the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident-Based Reporting System, known as NIBRS.

APD sends NIBRS data to the FBI on a regular basis and this data is based on the reports available at that point in time.


The data for this report were obtained from APD's records management system on Nov. 16, 2023. It reflects crime stats from January through September. There is a time delay before publishing the data on APD's web site to allow police reports to be approved by supervisors. The delay allows APD to provide more accurate crime stats to the public. Counts should be seen as preliminary and are subject to change as more than 3% of the month's total reports are still under review for NIBRS compliance

However, the data is still reported on a fixed point of time, and future reports will differ somewhat from these statistics.


### **Crime Category Totals**




#### Assault Offenses +5%




#### Homicide Offenses -23%



# Burglary/Breaking & Entering -19%






Citywide (January-September) 2022 vs 2023




#### Motor Vehicle Theft -11%




