APD Releases Details of Officer-Involved Shooting in May

ALBUQUERQUE – The Albuquerque Police Department released details of an officerinvolved shooting in May.

SUMMARY OF INCIDENT

Date of Incident: May 3, 2022 Location: 7640 Central Ave., S.E.

On May 3, 2022 at approximately 12:37 a.m., SE officers were dispatched to the Albuquerque Inn at 7640 Central Ave SE. While on the call for service officers began hearing multiple shots fired in the area between multiple vehicles.

One of the offender vehicles confronted officers in front of the Albuquerque Inn and began firing at the officers. At least one officer returned fire which prompted the vehicle to flee the area. No officers were injured by gunfire during this incident and no offender information has been located.

Subject: Unknown

Involved Officer:

Mark Holman, who has been with the department since 2019, has not been involved in prior officer-involved shootings.

Over the next several months, APD will continue to investigate and analyze this incident. Detectives will continue interviewing any new witnesses that come forward and complete any forensic tests. After the investigation is complete, APD's Force Review Board will forward the findings to the Superintendent of Police Reform to determine if this incident met the high standards of the Albuquerque Police Department. The Multi-Agency Task Force will forward its case to the District Attorney's Office to make any determination of criminal charges.
