Safety Tips—Stay Safe This Tax Season



If you receive an email claiming to be from the IRS that contains a request for personal information, taxes associated with a large investment, inheritance or lottery:

• Don't Reply

- Don't open any attachments. They can contain malicious code that may infect your computer or mobile phone.
- Don't click on any links.
- Forward the email as-is to Phishing@irs.gov.
- Delete the original email.

File Online for the following :

- Fraud—Your Credit Card was fraudulently used to make unauthorized purchases.
- Residential Burglary–Person(s) entering a residential dwelling without permission from the owner and removing or damaging items from within the dwelling.
- Auto Burglary–Person(s) entering a vehicle without permission from the owner and removing/stealing vehicle equipment or items from within the vehicle.
- Auto Vandalism—Any damage to a vehicle exterior, not including theft of parts or entry into vehicle.
- Lost Property–When property is missing or lost. Stolen License plates cannot be submitted on line.
- Telephone Harassment—Unwanted phone calls of an annoying, harassing or threatening nature.
- Theft or Larceny–Your property is taken without your permission.
- Vandalism—The act of damaging or defacing public or private property.
