Leaving spare change in a vehicle is also a target – the case yesterday cost the victim a broken window. I am seeing RVs and trailers targeted lately in the Foothills; not in large numbers, but still they are being burglarized. Treat these vehicles as targets just like you would your car and layer them with protective measures: removing all items of value, any items with personal information, considering parking them in secured areas behind gates or walls, have great lighting over these vehicles, consider alarms and cameras to capture a burglary if it does occur.
