Congratulations to the Mission Hills apartment community for participating in the Crime Free Multi-Housing partnership program with the Foothills Area Command Crime Prevention unit for 20 years!. The community manager, Mary Jane Clark, was presented with a plaque from Chief Geier for this milestone and accomplishment at the annual crime prevention meeting on property last night. The Crime Free Multi-Housing program partners Crime Prevention Specialists and APD officers in the community with apartment ownership/management teams to work on reducing criminal activity on rental properties. The program is free, voluntary and management must complete and maintain specified requirements of the program. The partnership is renewable on an annual basis if the property continues to meet the Crime Free program requirements.

**Quick Take-Aways:** Our residential burglaries reported in the Foothills Area Command yesterday were both cases of **entries to garages**. Please secure garage doors and the side doors to the garage if you have them. Think of the garage door as the biggest door to your home and secure that entry point accordingly. Remember to use the deadbolt on the door most of us have in the garage that leads into the home – don't provide access to your home via the garage to a burglar!
