

Trending Tuesday: Our APD Crime Analysis Unit tells us that the APD took 145 auto burglary reports from October 1 – 7, 2018. **The Foothills Area Command logged 18 auto burglaries for that week – the lowest among all six APD Area Commands.** The highs ranged from 32 auto burglaries for that week to the Foothills Area Command's 18. Remember to remind any houseguests, friends, or family visiting your home or our city during Balloon Fiesta to lock up vehicles and to leave nothing of value inside an unattended vehicle so that they can enjoy our city and all it has to offer with the odds in their favor of not being an auto burglary victim!
