How are burglars entering homes in the Foothills? For the most part, via sliding glass doors at the back of the home. I highly recommend adding security film to prevent breakage and for added privacy. There are also many types of anti-lift/anti-slide mechanisms that can be added to the sliding glass door to prevent it from being lifted or slid out of the tracks by a burglar. If you have an alarm, use it – most people have alarm systems and do not set them. Cameras can be a deterrent and can help police after an event has occurred. Layer your home with burglary prevention and you will greatly reduce your odds of being a burglary victim.

Do not discount how valuable good neighbors are –form Neighborhood Watch group with APD to learn a little about basic crime prevention, build some good neighborhood contact lists for each other and learn how to safely report crime and suspicious behavior.
