<u>2018-6 Massage Parlors & Human Trafficing (Draft for discussion & vote)</u> Problem: The numerous massage parlors in Albuquerque are often centers for human trafficking and present a serious moral and legal problem for the City due to federal human trafficking laws. Recommendation: Suggest Chief Geier consider increasing the number of officers assigned to the Vice Unit to identify and prosecute the traffickers of these establishments. In addition, we suggest that legal avenues be identified that could publicize the "Johns" that exploit these women and children.
