INTRODUCTION & DATA DISCLAIMERS

The Albuquerque Police Department uses the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) to report crime statistics. NIBRS is the most current national framework for reporting crime to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

APD's crime data system is dynamic and additional information may be added or refined after the data are sent to the FBI. Although FBI updates its data bases regularly, it does not update published reports.

In addition to NIBRS data, APD tracks certain crimes, such as homicides and shootings with injury, in real time and based on the current status of criminal investigations. For example, homicides are separated into non-negligent murders, justifiable homicides or negligent homicide, based on the investigation by detectives. That status could change with new evidence during the course of the investigation.

Enforcement data on the number of arrests, including warrant arrests, was obtained from APD's Records Management System.

Finally, the numbers in this report can't convey the damage that crime causes to its victims and to the community, nor can the numbers convey the courage and dedication of the men and women of the Albuquerque Police Department who do their best to keep our city safe.
