Zoom Meeting: July 17, 2020


Approximately 51 members of the public attended

2. APD Update: Commander Barker

- There has been a lot of speeding complaints, speeding trailers have been moved around to see when people are most active.
- PRT (Proactive Response Team) look into the panhandling and if people are homeless they provide them with resources.
- There will be a Bid starting to Lieutenants and Sergeants, in August all commands will have new officers in place.
