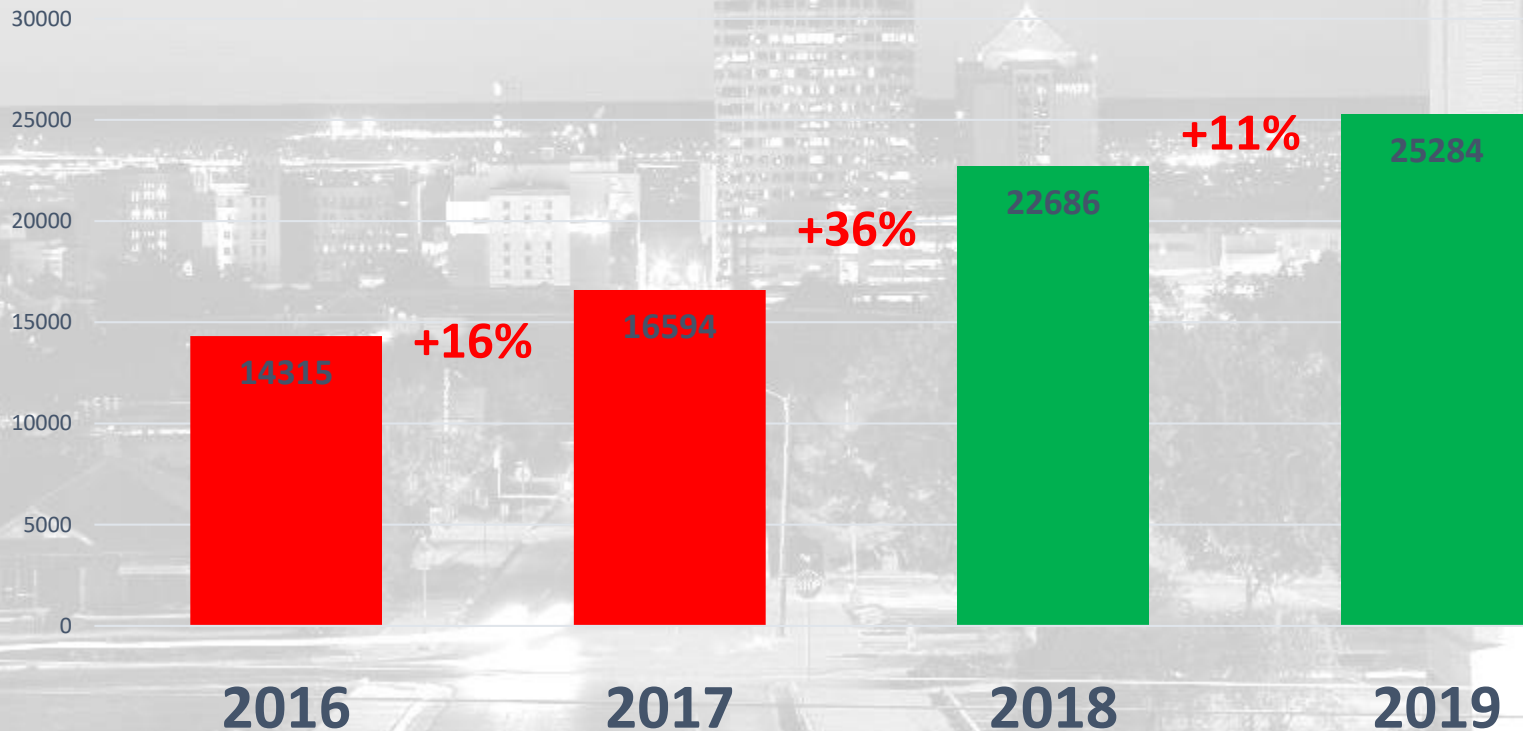

Traffic Stops INCREASED BY 77% since 2016





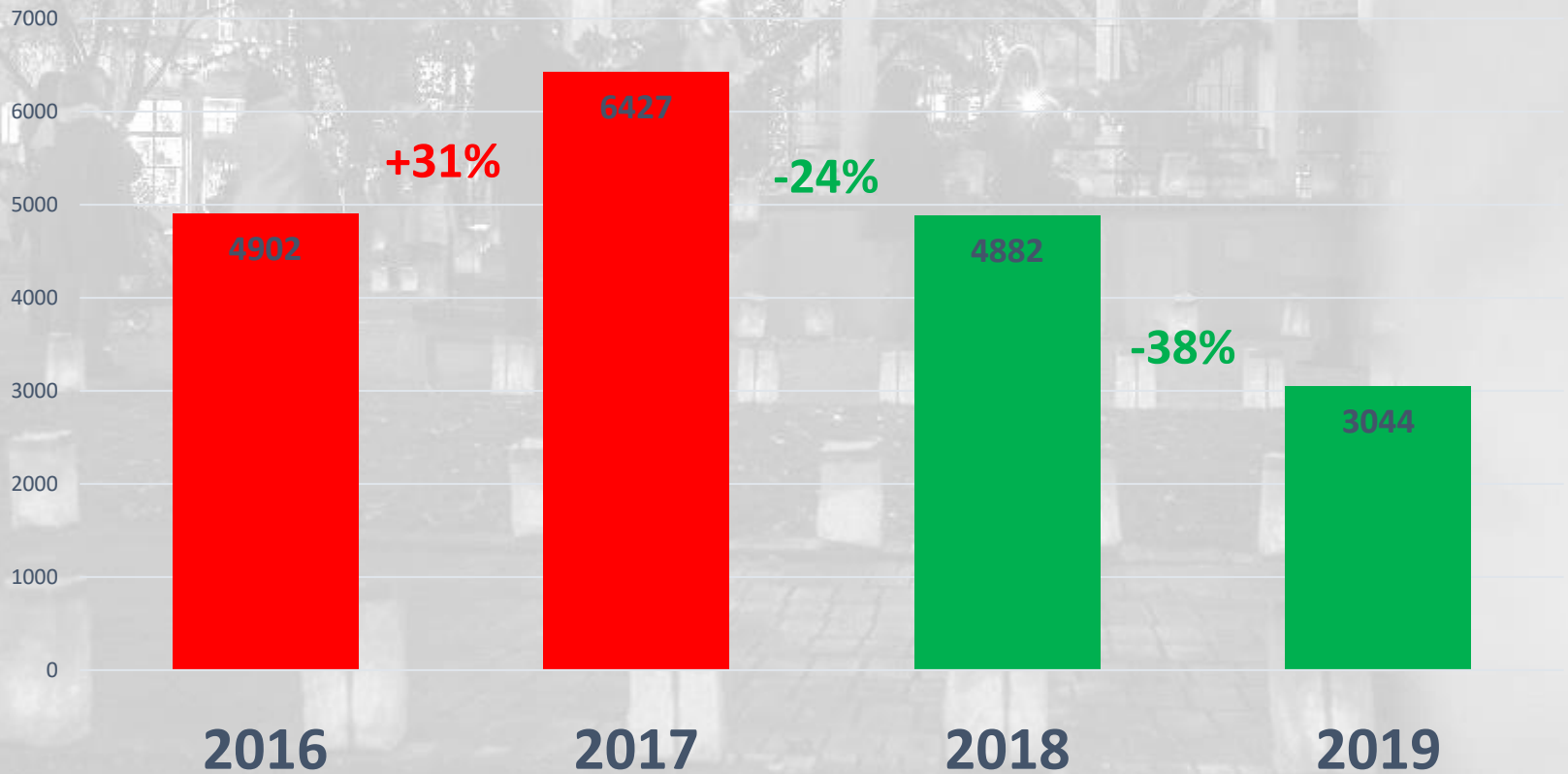

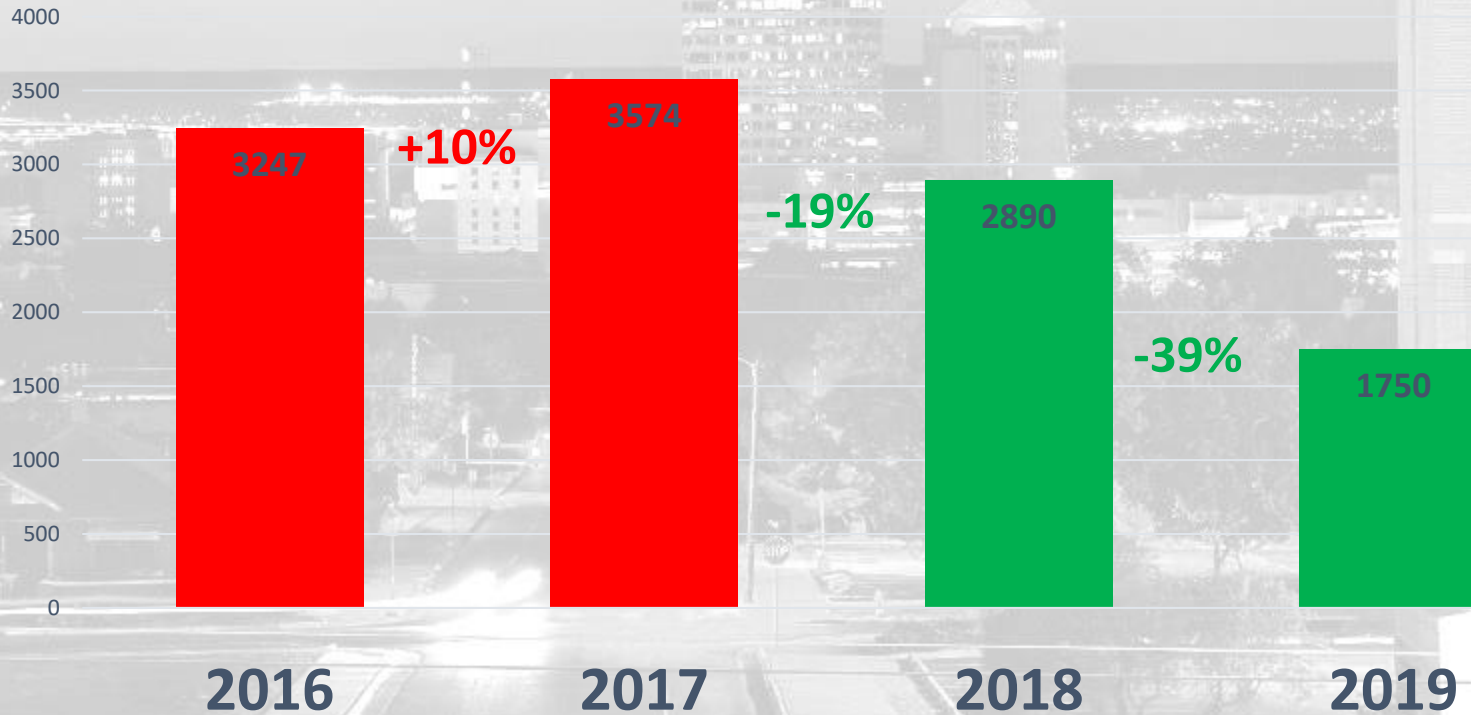
Auto Burglary - Mid-Year

53% DECREASE in auto burglaries since 2017



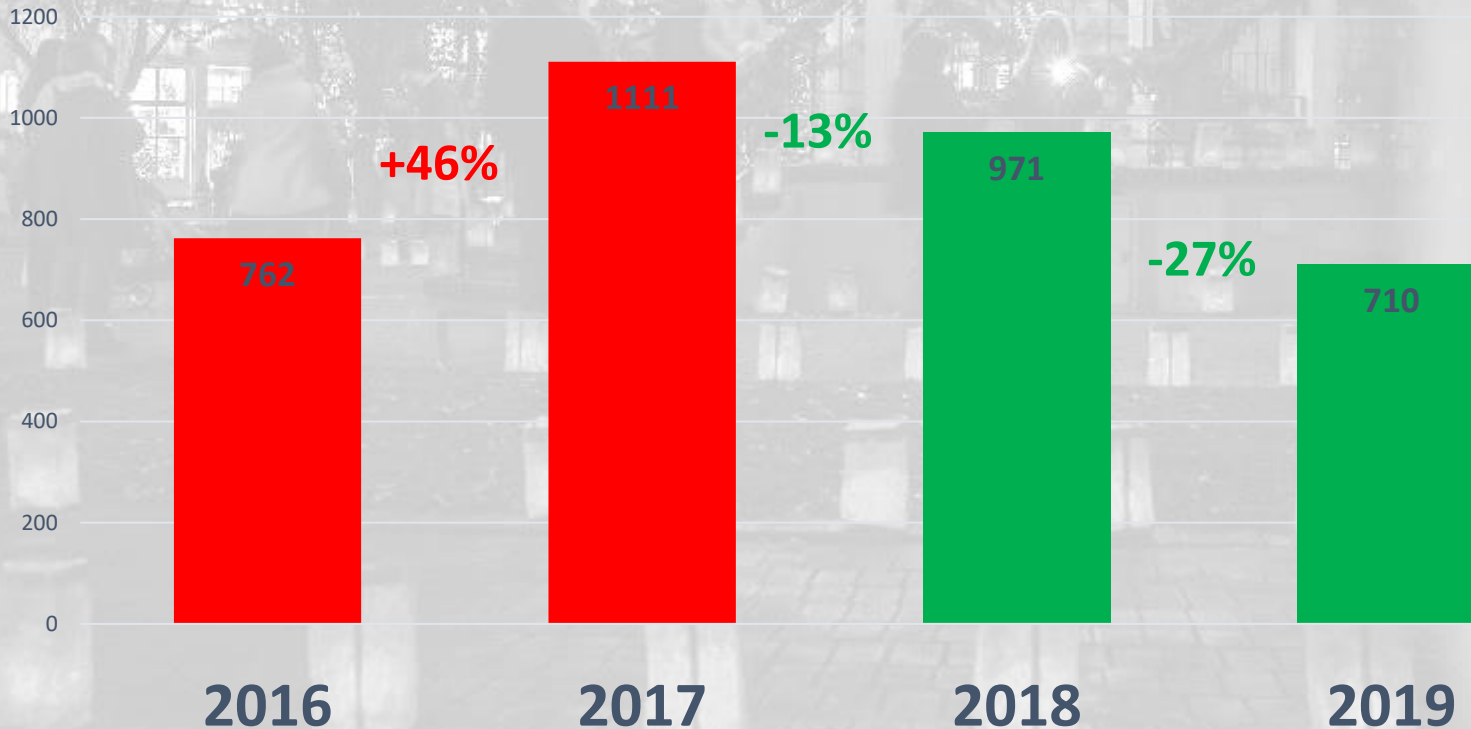
Auto Theft - Mid-Year

51% DECREASE since 2017



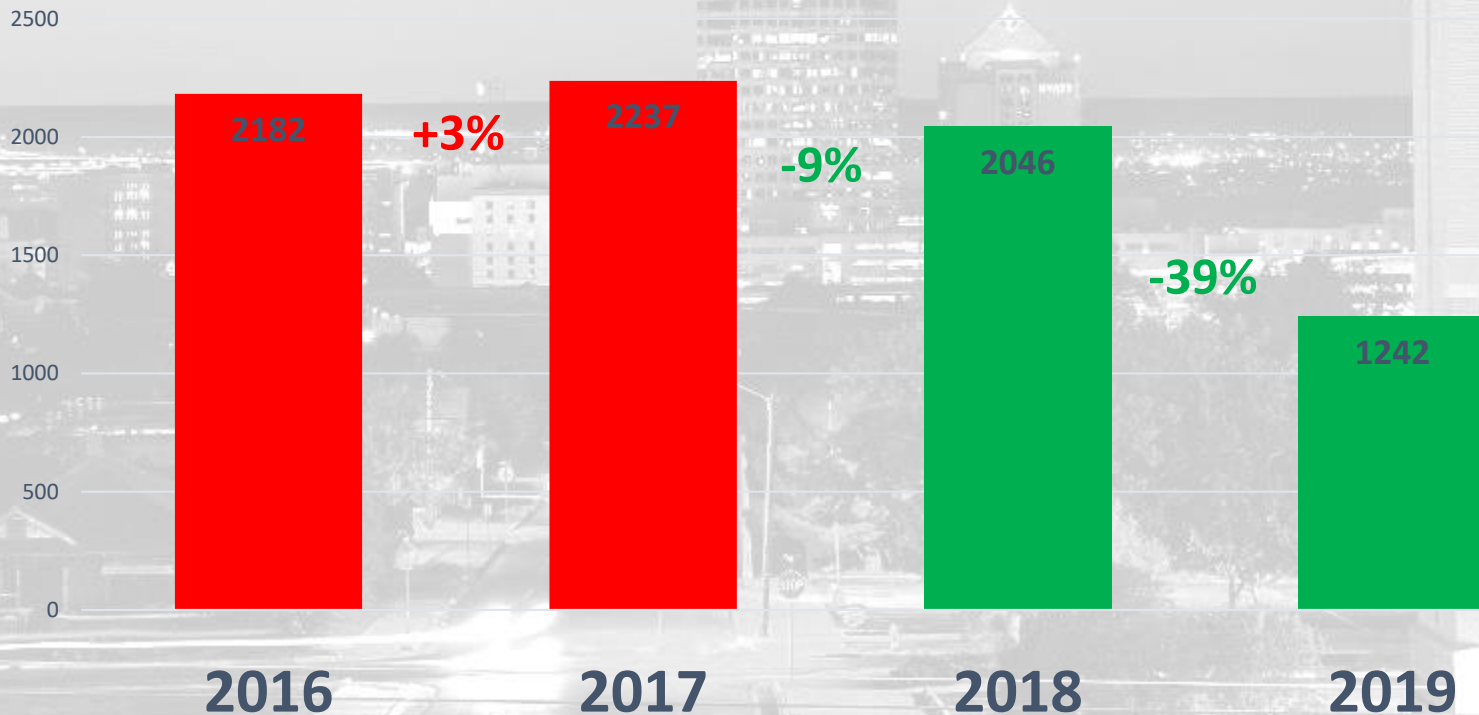
Commercial Burglary - Mid-Year

Property Crime Reduction

- Auto Burglary: **53% decrease** since 2017
- Auto Theft: **51% decrease** since 2017
- Commercial Burglary: **36% decrease** since 2017
- Residential Burglary: **44% decrease** since 2017



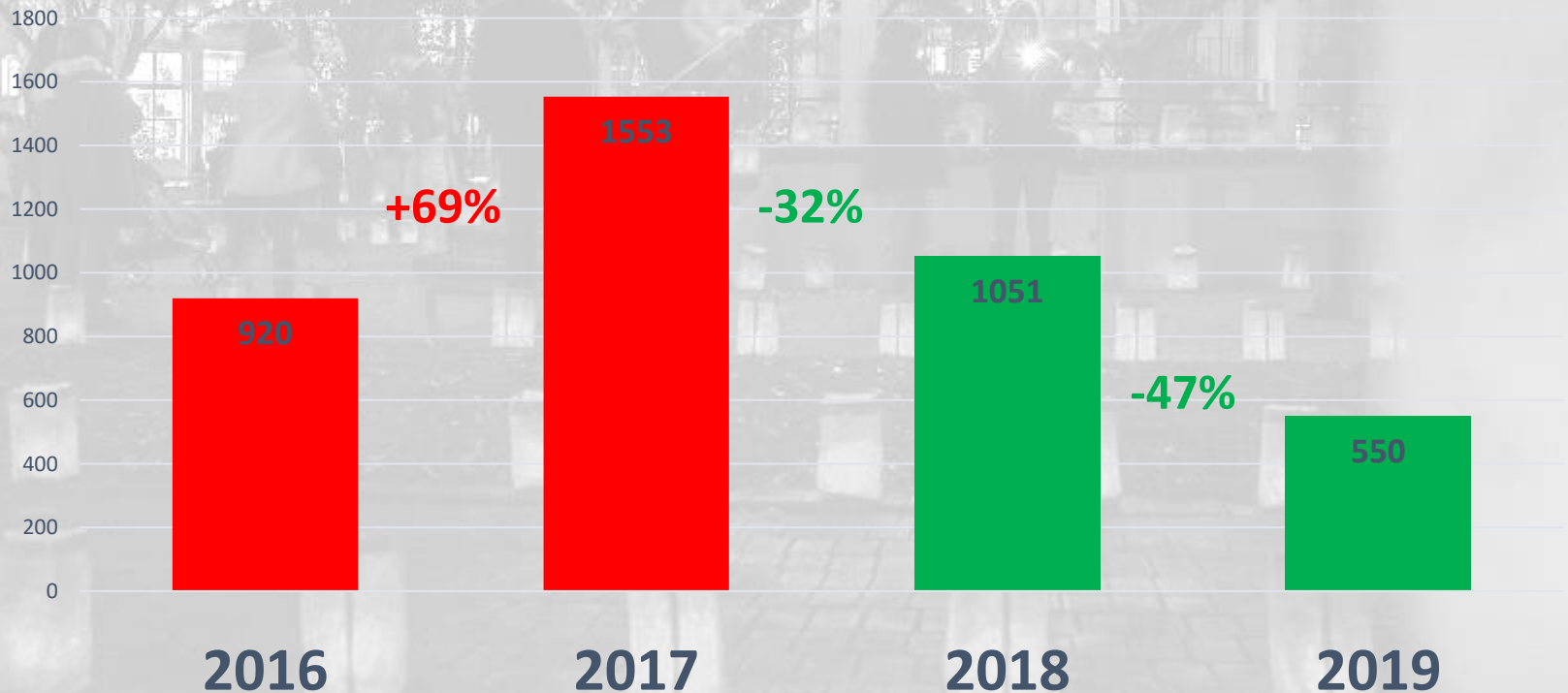

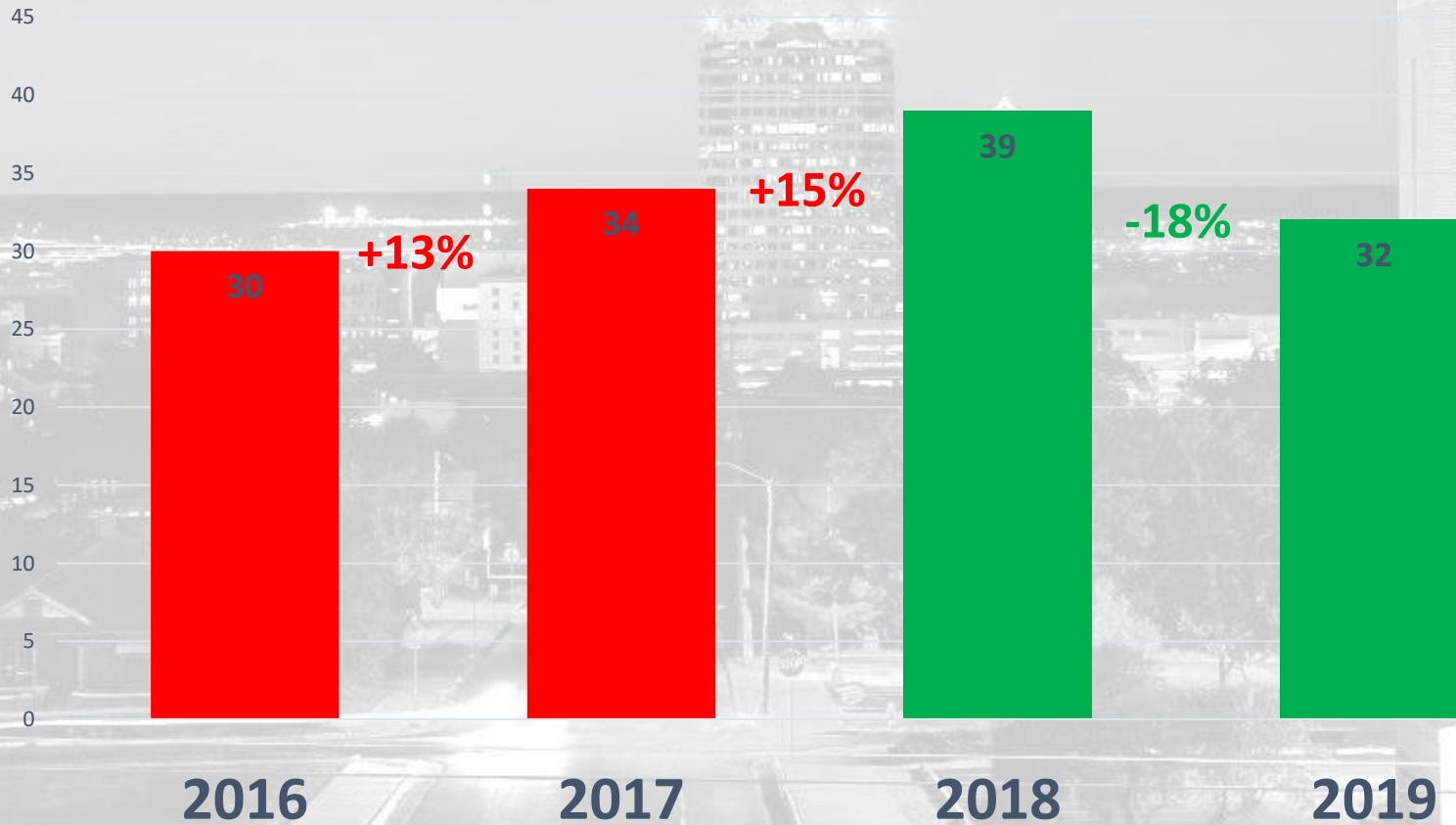
Robbery - Mid-Year

Robberies **DECREASED** by 65% since 2017



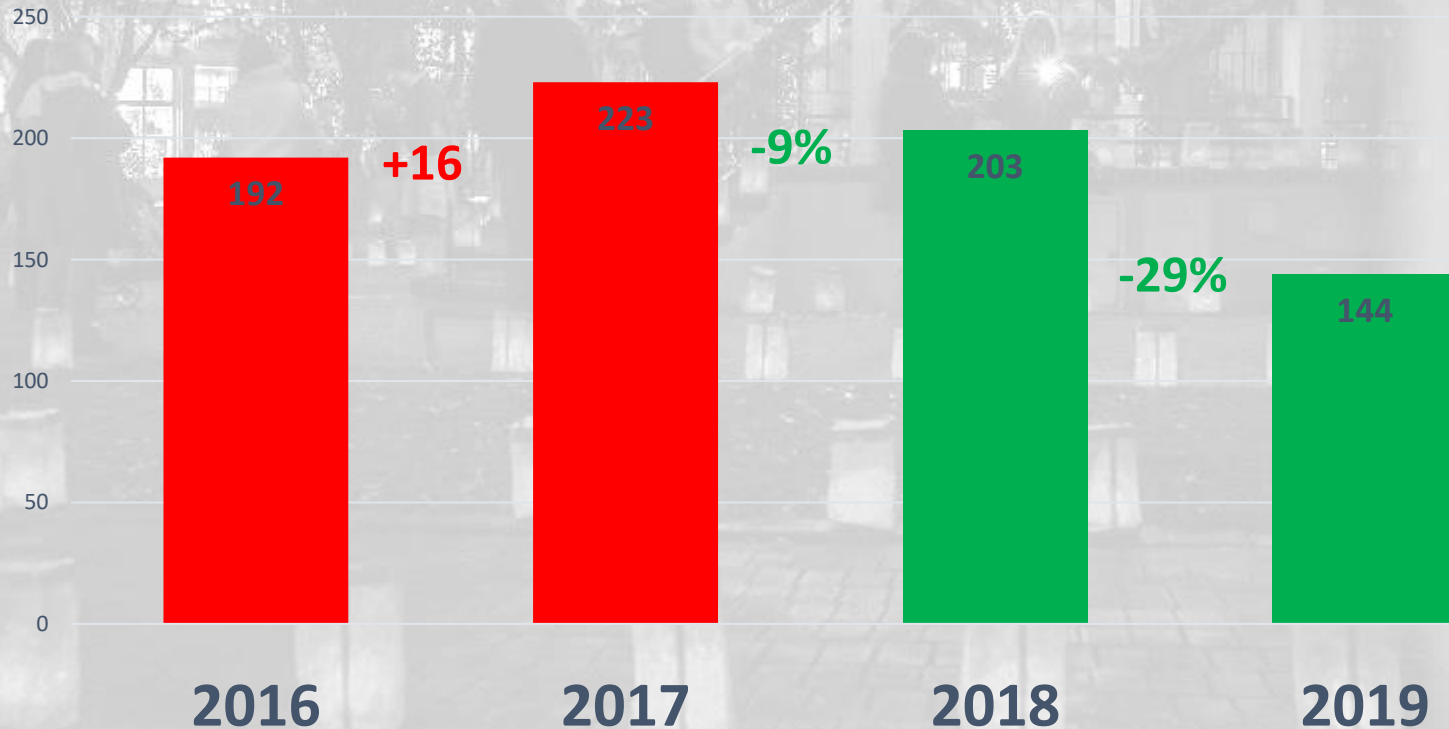
Robbery is categorized as violent crime because it involves the use of force.

Homicide – Mid-Year



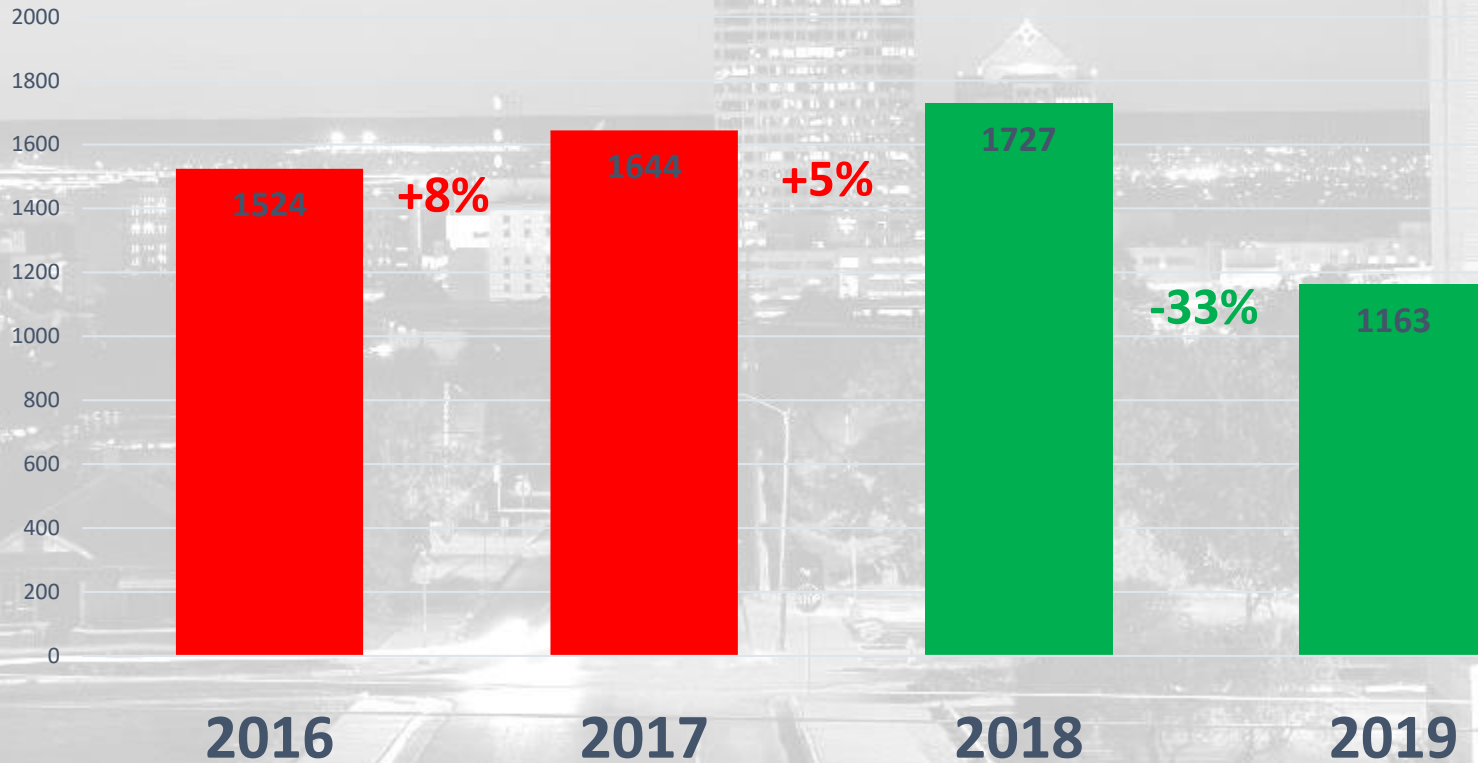
Rape - Mid-Year

Rape DECREASED by 35% since 2017



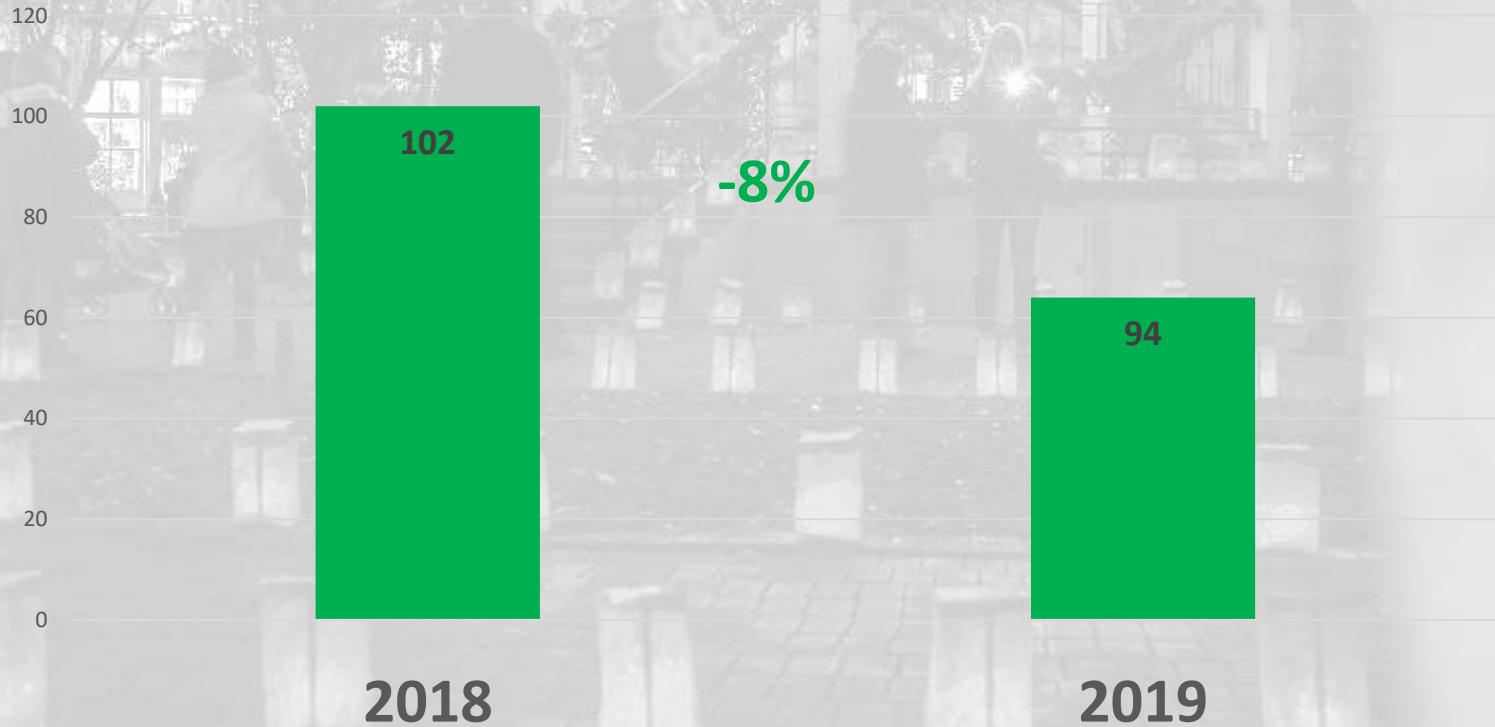
Aggravated Assault - Mid-Year

Violent Crime Reduction

- Robbery: **65% decrease** since 2017
- Homicide: **18% decrease** since 2018
- Rape: **35% decrease** since 2017
- Agg Assault: **33% decrease** since 2017
- Shooting w/Injury: **8% decrease** sine 2018
