

EVAPORATIVE COOLER START-UP SERVICE

Provided by the Home Services program for homeowners aged 60+ who reside in their home

Service Includes:

- Remove Cover and Damper(s)
- Clean Unit
- Oil Bearings
- Clean Water Distributor Tubes
- Change Pads, if needed,
 - MasterCool® pads are not supplied. Staff can install them if the homeowner provides them.
- Connect Waterline to an Exterior Spigot
 - Staff will not connect the waterline to a water heater or any interior water source.
- Connect Pump, Motor, and Drain Plug(s)
- Test Unit
- Adjust Float

If needed, one or more of the following new items can be provided and installed:

- Pump, Pump Hose, and/or Pump Basket,
- Spigot w/ Valve or Needle/Angle Valve,
- Distributor Tubes,
- Drain Plug,
- Waterline,
- Pulley,
- Float, and/or
- Belt,

Service Does Not Include:

- Repairs or Replacement of Motor, Blower(s), Mount(s), Duct(s), Thermostat, Controller, or Switch
- New Unit Installation
- Cover or Damper(s)
- More than one (1) Return Trip for Float Adjustment

For safety purposes, coolers on roofs with clay tiles or two-story homes cannot be serviced.

Services are provided by employees and/or volunteers who are not licensed plumbers or electricians.
